

New Features for Timekeeper Version 4.05

The 4.05 version of Timekeeper has been enhanced to use new features available in the Library Master Extensions module, and the .timekeeper application contains new features and extends support for a variety of browsers.

Uses New Settings in Remote User Maintenance

Two new fields are available in the Remote User Maintenance window which is accessible through the Main menu of the Library Master Extensions module. The .timekeeper application uses the **Default Company** and **Use Last Company** fields, which are user-specific options. .timekeeper defaults the company information in the Login window to the company specified in Remote User Maintenance. If the **Use Last Company** field is checked, .timekeeper will use the last active company as the default company. (See page 210 of the *Timekeeper Manual* for more information.)

.timekeeper Supports a Variety of Browsers

The .timekeeper application now supports the following browsers - Internet Explorer, Netscape, Opera, Mozilla, Firefox, and Safari. (See page 200 of the *Timekeeper Manual* for more information.)

.timekeeper Can Display Number of Records

Your company can set the new **Display Record Count** feature while configuring .timekeeper. When selected, .timekeeper displays a Work In Process list record count. (See page 207 of the *Timekeeper Manual* for more information.)

Display .timekeeper Lookup Lists by Name or Description

The .timekeeper application now contains the **Lookup by Name** feature, which allows you to display the Customer, Project, and Activity Lookup lists in alphabetical order by name/description rather than by code. (See page 219 of the *Timekeeper Manual* for more information.)

.timekeeper Work In Process List Display

In the last version of .timekeeper, when a record was edited or deleted, the Work In Process list would redisplay the first page of records. Now the list displays the last page you accessed instead of relaunching the first page.
